## 2. Why “E.T.”?

Today, we live in an increasingly globalized world, constantly exposed to new trends and parallel lives, and getting disconnected to the territories where we are.

With “E.T.” we want that to STOP for a week, and take time to reflect on what led us to these situations.

This is not about standing up against global tendencies. It is about focusing on territories that have been severely transformed by our society, and understanding how we can empower them.



## 3. Objectives of the project

- ✓ To reflect on how societies shape territories.
- ✓ To understand territorial disparities and their historical causes
- ✓ To experience social and territorial exodus processes at regional level
- ✓ To find out ways to promote territorial equality at local level
- ✓ To explore different actions that promote endurance of rural communities through time.
- ✓ To raise awareness about local cultures and traditions from different European realities.
- ✓ To grow personally and professionally by exchanging knowledge and experience with other European peers.



## 4. Venue



### **The hostel**

All the group will be accommodated at “Albergue Hayedo de Santiago” in Munilla. Rooms will be shared by 3 and 4 people. There are two big and renovated bathrooms.

### **The village**

Munilla has an attractive natural environment, it lies at the foot of mountains, offering a natural landscape. It's a perfect spot to experience the rural exodus in Spain with old stone houses, narrow streets, and the characteristic atmosphere of a traditional mountain village. There're only a couple bars, but there are shops and services in another town located 5 minutes away by car.

## 5. Economic conditions

Erasmus+ will cover the accommodation, meals, and travel costs of the participants, according to the Erasmus+ guidelines for 2025.

Reimbursement costs from/to Logroño (your travel destination):

100km – 499km = 211€ (green travel = 285€)

500km – 1999km = 309€ (green travel = 417€)

2000km – 2999km = 395€ (green travel = 535€)
