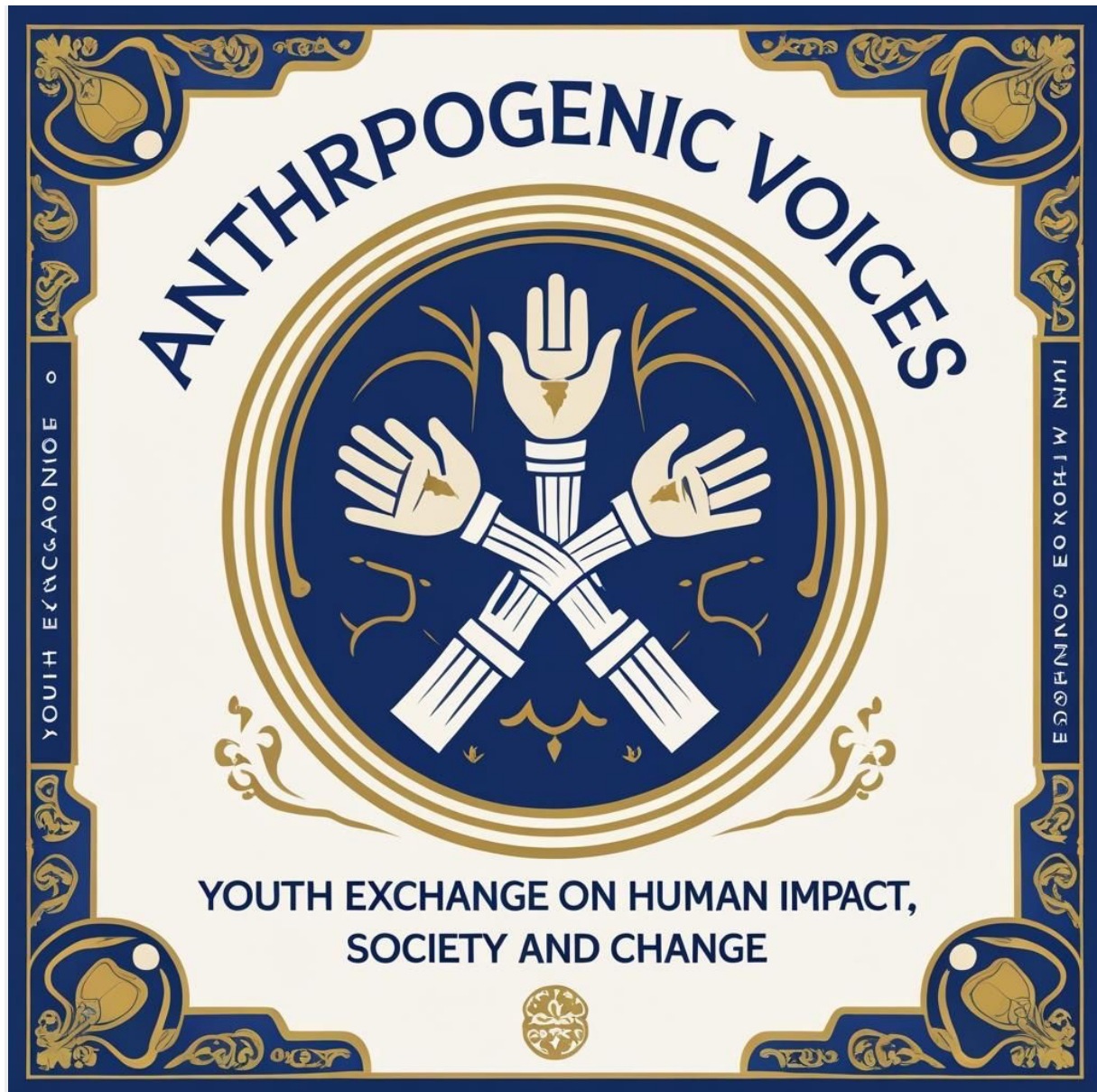

## What is *Anthropogenic Voices*?

How does human activity shape the future of our planet — and what role can young people play in changing that future?

**Anthropogenic Futures** is a 9-day youth exchange that brings together young people from different countries to explore **climate change, sustainability, green citizenship and civic responsibility** through **non-formal education, arts, outdoor learning and community interaction**.

This exchange invites participants to connect **mind, body and emotions** with environmental topics, transforming awareness into expression, creativity and action.

## Objectives of the Youth Exchange

By the end of the exchange, participants will:

- better understand climate change and human impact on the environment
- explore sustainability and green citizenship in everyday life
- develop civic awareness and responsibility as young Europeans
- express environmental messages through creative and artistic methods
- strengthen intercultural cooperation and teamwork
- reflect on personal values and future-oriented action

## Programme Overview (Short Agenda)

### **Arrival Day – 1st of August**

Welcome, getting to know each other, group contract, introduction to the project and Youthpass

### **Days 1–2: Climate Awareness & Green Citizenship**

Understanding climate change and anthropogenic impact through simulations, debates, community interviews and creative reflection

### **Day 3: Nature, Body & Emotion**

Outdoor learning, educational hike, sound exploration and eco-art workshops connecting emotions with environmental issues

### **Day 4: SDGs in Action**

Educational visits and introduction to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs); preparation for creative outputs

### **Day 5: Green Mobility & Urban Exploration**

Train journey to Braşov, urban exploration on circular economy and sustainability, intercultural teamwork

### **Day 6: Creation & Expression**

Development of short films, performances or artistic messages focused on SDGs and environmental responsibility

### **Day 7: Community Sharing**

Presentation of creative results and community performance

### **Day 8: Reflection & Youthpass**

Creative evaluation, reflection on learning outcomes, Youthpass completion and closing activities

## **Methodology**

The youth exchange is based on **non-formal education**, combining:

- simulation games and experiential learning
- artistic expression (theatre, music, visual arts)
- outdoor and nature-based activities
- community interaction and intercultural dialogue
- reflection, teamwork and peer learning

## Who Can Participate?

This youth exchange is for:

- young people **15–18 years old**
- interested in climate, environment and sustainability
- open to intercultural learning and group living
- motivated to express ideas creatively
- able to communicate in basic English

No prior experience is required — just curiosity and openness.

## Location

### **Breaza & Braşov, Romania**

A green and inspiring setting, combining mountains, nature, small-town life and urban exploration.

Accommodation and meals are provided according to Erasmus+ standards.

## Costs & Reimbursement

Travel, accommodation and food are covered according to **Erasmus+ Youth Exchange rules**.

Travel reimbursement is provided based on distance bands and upon submission of travel documents.

Participants are encouraged to choose **green travel options** when possible.
